“Eyes and Ears of the Cold War”
Featuring Don and Anna Peterson
Thursday, January 24, 11:00 am

Don and Anna Peterson spent their separate professional careers in the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). Between them, their service spanned almost the entire length of the Cold War. They will talk about their personal journeys and what it was like to work for this storied organization at that time.

Don joined the CIA in 1951, only four years after the CIA came into being, and spent most of his career in the Foreign Broadcast Information Service. He started as a desk editor and served them during four overseas posts. He went on to become Director of FBIS. In the pre-digital world, FBIS was almost always first with serious news breaks around the world.

Anna joined the CIA in 1955, married Don in 1956 and accompanied him on his overseas tours for the next 10 years. Between 1955 and 1994, she carved out a 30-year career serving in the Clandestine Service as an editor, translator, training officer and finally, as director of a project providing foreign language support to CIA operations abroad.
